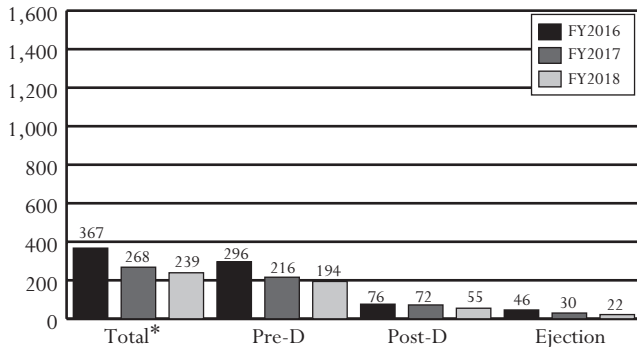

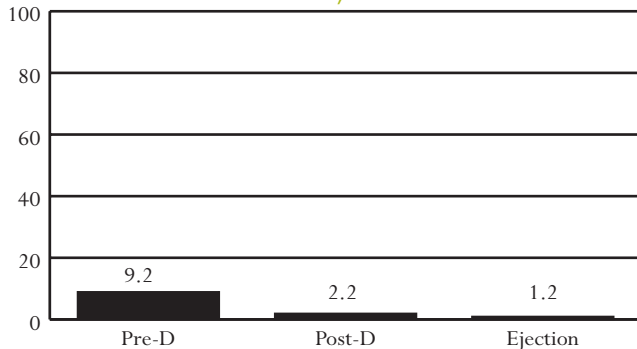

• Source of Admissions (FY 2018):

- 98.3% of admissions were from regions within Maryland. Of those from Out-of-State, 2 were from Virginia and 1 was each from Washington, D.C. and West Virginia.

• Admission Trends:

- Total admissions decreased 34.9% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 10.8% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- Pre-D admissions decreased 34.5% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 10.2% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- Post-D admissions decreased 27.6% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 23.6% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- Ejection admissions decreased 52.2% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 26.7% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.

• Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI):

- The percentage of Pre-D placements with a DRAI decreased 8.0% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and increased 1.5% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.

• Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- For cases involving a transfer from facility to facility, the total ALOS is reflected on the statewide pages. The specific facility's page reflects only the ALOS at that particular facility.
- ALOS for Pre-D increased 9.7% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 9.3% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- Post-D ALOS increased 2.4% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 6.9% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- ALOS for ejections increased 203.8% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and increased 41.7% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.

• Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2016-2018:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence decreased from 24.7% to 17.0%
- The percentage of Felonies increased from 13.0% to 14.9%
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 58.2% to 59.3%

• Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP decreased 23.9% between FY 2016 and FY 2018 and decreased 14.5% between FY 2017 and FY 2018.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

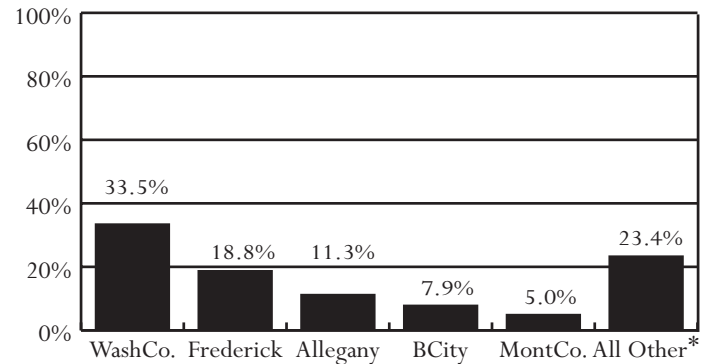

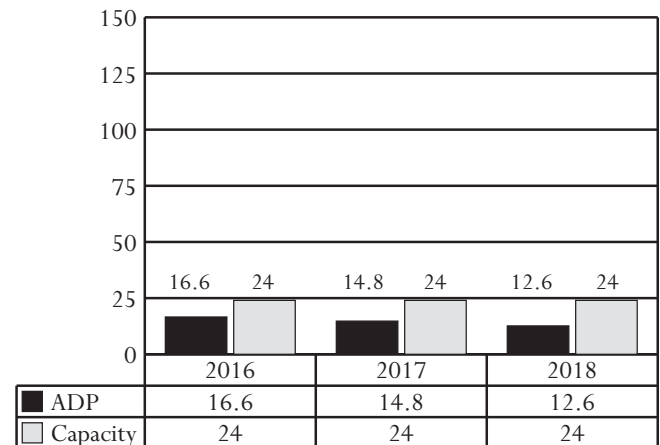
